


The Numbers

- 118,600 drinking at potentially harmful levels
- 25,800 drinking at levels harming current health
- Most adults drink within safe limits
- 17,500 hospital admissions per annum
- Around 100,000 A&E attendances per annum
- 1,200 ambulance callouts for overdose per annum
- 1,600 people in structured alcohol treatment
- 200 deaths specifically due to alcohol per annum
- Around 150,000 working days lost per annum
- 3,800 alcohol-related crimes per annum
- 15,000 people employed (bars, breweries etc.)


Types of Health Condition

Mental Conditions

Mental and behavioural problems caused by alcohol use



Chronic Conditions


Long-term conditions and health problems caused by prolonged increased alcohol usage







Admissions by Age and Type







Summary
